
eBeam Quick Reference

Desktop Wheel



Annotate: Takes you to the Annotate wheel and allows you to annotate on top of any program open.

PowerPoint: Opens an open dialog to select an existing PowerPoint to open. Automatically starts the presentation.

Handwriting Recognition: Tap once to turn on and once again to turn off. This tool allows you to write on the board and turns your handwriting into text.


Options: Allows you to change options of eBeam such as size of wheel and transparency.

Mouse: This tool simply means that you can use your pen as your computer's mouse.

Snapshot: Allows you to take a snapshot of any picture or item on your screen and use it in your presentation.

Scrapbook: Takes you to the scrapbook which is the software that comes with the eBeam.

Calibrate: configures the projection area on the computer. Tap in the middle of the nine points.



Annotate Wheel

Pen: Allows you to write like a pen on top of whatever is on your screen.

Special Shapes: Allows you to create shapes like arrows, boxes and circles.

Redo: Redoes the last item undone.

Eraser: Allows you to erase annotations.

Mouse: This tool will take you back to the desktop wheel and get rid of all annotations on screen.


Save: Allows you to take save your annotations.

Undo: Undoes the last mark made.

Highlighter: Allows you to highlight information on screen.

PowerPoint Wheel

Only available in PowerPoint presentation mode



Pen: Allows you to write on top of your PowerPoint.

Special Shapes: Allows you to create shapes on presentation.

Next Slide: Takes you to the next slide in your presentation.


Eraser: Allows you to erase annotations on PowerPoint.

Mouse: This tool simply means that you can use your pen as your computer's mouse.

End Presentation: Takes you out of presentation mode in PowerPoint.

Previous Slide: Takes you to the last slide viewed in your presentation.

Highlighter: Allows you to highlight on PowerPoint presentation.



Pen: Allows you to write on your slide.

Text Box: Creates a box you can type in or use handwriting recognition with.

Handwriting Recognition: Tap once to turn on and once again to turn off. This tool allows you to write on the board and turns your handwriting into text.

Eraser: Allows you to erase the pen or highlighter from your slide.

Selector: This tool allows you to select multiple items on slide to apply things to.

New Page: Creates a new slide within scrapbook.

Zoom: Allows you to zoom to any part of your slide.

Highlighter: Allows you to highlight on top of items within your slide.
